Seasonal Showcase Will Include Open-Air Skating Rink, Snow, Holiday Movies, Santa Claus, And More

Orlando, Fla. (Nov. 14, 2018) – Lake Nona is kicking off the holiday season with a flurry of activities for the whole family. From Dec. 8 – 30 in Lake Nona Town Center, *Oh What Fun! In addition to classic holiday treats, food and beverage options are available from Lake Nona Town Center restaurants including Chroma Modern Bar + Kitchen, Bosphorous Turkish Cuisine, and the recently-opened Park Pizza & Brewing Co. Outdoor entertainment district Boxi Park is also expected to open by the end of the year.
